FRANCE: COGNAC

Cognac is simply a type of brandy. Where whisky is distilled from grains, brandy is distilled from fermented fruit juice (or wine). In the simplest definition, Cognac is simply a brandy that uses specific grapes grown, fermented and distilled in the Cognac region of France, where the spirit derives its name. So, all Cognac is brandy, but not all brandy is Cognac.

LOUIS XIII

Louis XIII is a truly stunning Cognac from Rémy Martin.

First created by Paul-Émile Rémy Martin all the way back in 1874, this complex Grande Champagne Prestige Cognac is crafted from the oldest and rarest eaux-de-vie passed down by generations of cellar masters and carefully selected. Some was distilled more than 100 years ago!

Not only is the spirit a work of art, but the handcrafted and individually numbered crystal decanter is also distinctively glorious too, with its shape inspired by a royal flask found on a battlefield back in the 1500s.

THE BASIC PROCESS OF WHISKY MAKING



PREPARATION

Various grains are ground and cooked. Barley is malted, a process of soaking the barley and spreading it for about three weeks, allowing it to sprout, and drying and heating it.



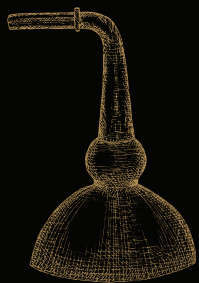
MASHING

The cooked grain and malted barley are added to warm water, which converts into a liquid known as wort.



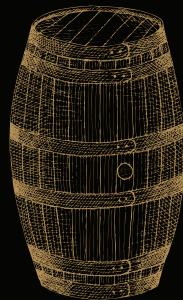
FERMENTING

The wort is added to a fermentation tank, along with yeast. The yeast converts the sugar to alcohol. After three or four days, the resulting liquid is about 10% alcoholic and is known as distiller's beer, or wash.



DISTILLING

The wash is heated to the point where the alcohol turns to vapor, but the water remains liquid. The alcohol is then collected in a second container. This process is repeated to produce "high wine" or "new whisky."



AGING

Water is added to the high wine, which is aged in wooden barrels, usually made from charred white oak. Here the whisky ages at least three or four years, and some are aged up to ten or fifteen years.



BOTTLING

The resulting whisky is stored in glass bottles, which do not react with the whisky's flavor.

HOW TO DRINK YOUR WHISKY

WHISKY NEAT

The golden standard of whiskey sipping glasses, the Glencairn. Get your perfect swirl on with its short, sturdy base. It's the best multipurpose sniffing and tasting glass for all whiskies. The small, but thick neck and narrow rim focuses the aromas, and diffuses the smell. With a Glencairn glass, you'll appreciate the subtleties in the whiskey through smell and taste.



WHISKY WITH A SPLASH OF WATER

Adding a splash of water, opens up the whisky. It releases a rich mix of aromas and accentuates its taste boosting delicate, complex flavours. The amount of water you add is always a personal choice, however too much of dilution can make the whisky lose its essential flavour.



WHISKY ON THE ROCKS

When you serve whisky on the rocks, two main things happen. First, you are diluting the drink. This means that the alcohol percentage in the whisky is being lowered, which can moderate the stronger flavours and particular characteristics of the spirit. This initially can actually reveal new dimensions of the whisky, as the water will interact with the whisky to change the composition of the spirit.

Second, drinking whisky on the rocks chills the whisky. This obviously changes the flavours that are revealed in the whisky as you experience it.

ISLAY

SCOTLAND: ISLAY

Islay (pronounced 'eye-luh') is a magical island where the majority of its population are involved in whisky production. Famous for fiery, heavily peated whiskies. The Islay malts are generally described as having a peaty or smoky character derived from the peat, which is burned and used to dry the barley during the malting stage. The island malts are known for being powerful, flavourful and full of character.

ARBEG WE BEASTIE 5 YEARS OLD • 47.4 % ABV

Nose: There's sea spray, rock pools, smoked malt and damp bonfire wood initially which waves of sweet and slightly vegetal smoke powers through. Hints of brown sugar, pear drops, a little vanilla and cooked apple add sweetness among notes of spare ribs, lemon sherbet, black pepper and wood shavings. I love this nose, it's smoky and musty and like standing by a seaside bonfire.

Finish: The finish is exceptionally long and oily. It's a bit like sucking on a lemon sherbet and taking a great big whiff of some freshly cut peat, to be honest. While standing on a beach. Lovely.

ARBEG 10 YEARS OLD • 46 % ABV

Nose: A ridge of vanilla leads to mountain of peat capped with citrus fruits and circled by clouds of sea spray.

Finish: Long and glorious; sea salted caramel and beach bonfire smoke.

BUNNAHABHAIN 12 YEARS OLD • 46.3 % ABV

Nose: Fresh, sweet, and a little floral. There's seaweed, rich malt, dried fruit, camphor, caramel, chocolate orange, and apple poached in cinnamon.

Finish: Mochaccino, dried herbs, Christmas cake spice, and a balanced salty tang.

Nose: Roasted peanuts, cinnamon and red chilli flakes, blackcurrant and Port.

Nose: Coastal smoke and ash soon make way for bergamot, orange zest, lemon slices and some hay before becoming rather floral, heather smoke now competing with the ash.

Finish: Smoky and long. Sea spray, dry grass, a touch of ash and citrus.

BOWMORE 15 YEARS OLD • 43 % ABV

Nose: Dark and punchy. Sherry notes, juicy Corinth raisins. Spices. Creamy, mochaccino, sweet dates.

Finish: Spicy, toffee, sherry, barley.

Nose: Pungent, citrus. Stewing fruit, hints of damp wood and a very soft smoke.

LAPHROAIG OAK SELECT • 40 % ABV

Nose: Classic, medicinal peat notes up front, supported by citrus-y, chocolate-y sweet notes and soft barley.

Finish: Medium length, peat remaining in sight until it's over.

LAPHROAIG 10 YEARS OLD • 40 % ABV

Nose: This opens on big, smoky muscular peat notes. There are spices, and liquorice, as well as a big dose of salt. This whisky has become slightly sweeter in recent years, and it appears beautifully on the nose, amidst the classic iodine/sticking plasters and cool wood smoke we love.

Finish: Big and drying, as the savoury, tarry notes build up with an iodine complexity.

LAGAVULIN 8 YEARS OLD • 48 % ABV

Nose: Salted popcorn, honey-roasted nuts, tarry ropes and light hints of freshly-chopped cedar. A touch of burnt sugar sweetness lingers.

Finish: Smokey peat appears first on the palate, followed by coriander seed, barley sugar, cumin powder, smoked kipper and marzipan.

LAGAVULIN 12 YEARS OLD 2023 * • 56.4 % ABV

Nose: Padrón pepper, spent bonfire, stone fruit, white chocolate, and charred pineapple.

Finish: Salted popcorn and toffee.

Nose: More like Lapsang Souchong tea than Lapsang Souchong! One of the smokiest noses from Islay. It's big, very, very concentrated, and redolent of iodine, sweet spices, good, mature Sherry and creamy vanilla. Stunning.

Finish: Long, spicy finish, figs, dates, peat smoke, vanilla.

Nose: Elegantly sweet with honey'd barley, boiled sweets and orange petals. Wafts of sea air.

Nose: Salted caramel brownie, flamed orange peel, a hearty whack of seaweed.

Finish: Ginger snaps, rye toast, drying peat smokiness.

HIGHLAND

SCOTLAND: HIGHLAND

This region, which also takes in the islands, has a huge diversity of flavours and characters. From lighter whiskies all the way through salty coastal malts, the Highlands offers a Scotch for all palates. The largest whisky region in terms of size, covering a vast area and diverse range of distilleries. Whiskies made here are known for a heavier and drier character, with hints of nut, honey and heather.

ABERFELDY 12 YEARS OLD • 40 % ABV

Nose: Creamy. Some sherried fruit with a trailing hint of smoke.
Honeyed prunes, custard, and espresso beans.

Finish: Ginger, malt, nutty nougat, and maybe a little grapefruit zest.

ABERFELDY 21 YEARS OLD • 40 % ABV

Nose: Runny honey, dried fruits, and biscuity malt enlivened
by a fresh, zesty quality, and notes of waxed citrus.

Finish: Ripe white peach, sultanas, and a good wave of honey, a smidge of wood
smoke, backed up by caramelised almonds and a touch of toasted coconut.

38

GLENMORANGIE 10 YEARS OLD • THE ORIGINAL • 40 % ABV

Nose: Very fruity and thick. Rich notes of lemon, nectarine and apple. Spices.

Finish: Quite long, gentle, malty and very fruity.

GLENMORANGIE LASANTA 12 YEARS OLD • THE ORIGINAL • 40 % ABV

Nose: The nose is inviting and very orange – Jaffa Cakes and marmalade – initially. It retains this note throughout, every time you nose it again there's more heaps of marmalade, spread on a buttery croissant for good measure. But stone fruits emerge too, think tinned peaches and nectarines, as well as banana bread, caramel shortbread, Brazil nuts, oak char, and a flowery perfumed quality.

Finish: The finish is crisp and almost a little tart with tropical
fruit sweetness, green apple, chalky minerality, and honey.

GLENMORANGIE THE QUINTA RUBAN 14 YEARS OLD • 46 % ABV

Nose: Summer fruit tart with a sprinkling of icing sugar,
aromatic cedar, milky coffee and almond pastries.

Finish: Lasting richness of stewed berries and dark chocolate.

SCOTLAND: HIGHLAND

GLENMORANGIE A TALE OF TOKYO • 46 % ABV

Nose: Sandalwood, incense, dried cherries, vanilla, star anise, and that trademark Glenmorangie tangy orange note.

IRELAND: WHISKEY

In many ways, the story of Irish whiskey is the story of whisky itself. In essential terms, it's a spirit made from fermented grains, distilled and aged in wooden casks for a minimum of three years. Those are the basics, but this simple definition conceals a rich culture, an incredible spectrum of flavours, and the significance of Ireland to the history of whisky the world over.

While Irish whiskey is often stereotyped as light and delicate as compared to Scotch or bourbon, it actually encompasses a great breadth of styles. These range from richly sherried pot still whiskies with a distinctive spiciness, to bright and tropical blends and even robustly smoky single malts.

JAMESON • 40 % ABV

Nose: A full and floral nose leads with the smooth sweetness of marmalade and fudge before a hint of Madeira and a little cut grass note emerge.

Finish: Medium-length with spice and honey.

GREEN SPOT SINGLE POT STILL • 40 % ABV

Nose: Hints of peppermint, malt, sweet barley, sugary porridge, creamy vanilla, papaya and citrus.

Finish: Creamy, long finish, vanilla.

U.S.A: BOURBON

Bourbon whiskey is a popular type of American Whiskey that has been distilled from at least 51% corn. It needs to be aged in new oak barrels, produced and bottled in America, as well as being 80 proof or more after distillation for it to legally qualify under the name "Bourbon". Bourbon can have no minimum aging period before consumption but typically takes on characteristics like spiciness and sweetness over time due its use of flavorful wood casks during production.

BULLEIT FRONTIER • 45 % ABV

Nose: Bright with orange zest, toasted oak and vanilla.

Finish: Smooth and spicy.

BUFFALO TRACE • 40 % ABV

Nose: Spicy and sweet with caramel, creamy toffee eclairs, hints of cinnamon, rum spice and cereal sweetness.

U.S.A: RYE WHISKEY

Rye whiskey is an American spirit made with at least 51 % rye, corn and barley. The fermentation process follows the distilling process of bourbon. Rye that has been aged for two years or more without being blended can be dubbed as "straight rye." Straight ryes tend to have a spicier flavor than sweeter bourbons due to their unfiltered nature which allows them retain some spice notes like cinnamon, herbs and fresh spices alike in its natural form.

SAZERAC STRAIGHT RYE • 45 % ABV

Nose: Sweet with spices and stem ginger in syrup. Orange zest, freshly ground black pepper and mixed peels.

Finish: An oily, spicy finish.

U.S.A: TENNESSEE WHISKEY

Tennessee whiskey is a type of bourbon made in the state of Tennessee, and it has some additional requirements that make it unique. The first requirement for this special drink to be considered such is that they must have been produced within its home state. Secondly, Tennessee whiskey can only be aged if filtered through charred maple wood chips before aging; what's more known as Lincoln County process or charcoal mellowing. For just like Bourbon but with an extra sweetness due to their filtering process which may include caramel-like tones; Tennessee Whiskey offers something different than your usual cold one: "good taste without fire."

JACK DANIEL'S OLD NO.7 • 40 % ABV

Nose: Light with plenty of sweetness. There are hints of dry spice and oily nuts, a touch of smoke.

Finish: Sweet with a little cereal sweetness and toasty oak.

JACK DANIEL'S SINGLE BARREL • 45 % ABV

Nose: Good body with plenty of toasty oak, there are notes of corn and lovely cereal sweetness, there is a good smoke note, a little spice and toffee.

CANADA



CANADA: BLENDED WHISKY

Canadian whisky shares many of the same characteristics as its North American brethren in the United States as well as maintains strong links to Scotch whisky.

Similar to Scotch, Canadian whisky distillers can use barrels previously used in the production of other spirits, such as sherry and rum, whilst also using various types of grains during distillation in order to create unique and differentiated flavours, exactly like American whiskey does.

Canadian whisky must also be entirely distilled within Canada and be aged in oak for at least three years.

CANADIAN CLUB 1858 ORIGINAL • 40 % ABV

The nose is of medium-body with notes of barley sugar and aniseed, notes of cut grass and fennel, a hint of straw and a vegetal freshness. The palate is quite sweet and gentle. There are notes of winter spice and dark sugars, a touch of rum. The finish is of medium-sweetness and of medium-length.

CROWN ROYAL • 40 % ABV

The most famous of all the Canadian whiskies, Crown Royal is made with over 50 different whiskies, and they've been making it for over 70 years. It was first created in 1939 to celebrate the visit of King George VI to Canada.

CANADA: RYE WHISKY

Canadian rye must be a potable alcoholic distillate, or a mixture of potable alcoholic distillates, obtained from a mash of cereal grain or cereal grain products, mashed, distilled, and matured in Canada. Corn, wheat, barley, triticale, and rye are counted among these cereal grains.

LOT NO. 40 • 43 % ABV

Nose: Earthy rye kicks in right away, backed up by caramel, fig and flamed orange peel.

Finish: Classic rye spiciness lingers.

JAPAN: BLENDED WHISKY

Japanese whisky and scotch have many similarities but how blended whisky is made is not one of them. In Scotland, distilleries often will exchange whisky with other distilleries to create blends. In Japan, Suntory, Nikka, and the other distilleries do not have this same practice. For Japanese whisky distilleries, this means that each company must be self-reliant masters at every single whisky used for their expressions. For this reason, Japanese whisky companies will own multiple distilleries in different climates. In addition to that they will have multiple styles of stills as well as many different barrels so they can create richly layered blends entirely self-sufficiently.

TOKI SUNTORI • 43 % ABV

Nose: Soft orchard fruits and thyme honey are joined by a helping of peppermint in the backdrop.

Finish: White pepper and ginger add spice to the finish.

NIKKA TAKETSURU PURE MALT • 43 % ABV

Nose: Grassy malt, earthy vanilla, toasted coconut and BBQ pineapple.

Finish: Lingering peat smoke and subtle baking spice warmth.

Nose: Bourbon-like vanilla and corn notes with a herbal hint of chamomile.

MEXICO: TEQUILA

To be called Port, the grapes must be grown in the Upper Douro region of northern Portugal, the most mountainous wine region in the world, and a Unesco World Heritage Site. Douro also has the distinction of being the world's first officially demarcated wine region, created in 1756, the only place in the world that can produce authentic Port.



Port is always a blend of different native grape varieties, and there are dozens of them, most of which you probably haven't heard of, with the most common being red: Touriga Franca, Touriga Nacional, Tinta Barroca, Tinto Cão, and Tinta Roriz (aka Tempranillo). White Port, on the other hand, comes from obscure white wine grapes like Códèga, Gouveio, and Malvasia Fina. But don't worry, you won't be tested on these names!
